SPECIALTY CLINICS

Classical Acupuncture Clinic

Classical Acupuncture is school of thought drawing from the Nei Jing and other classical texts, that utilizes 5 complete and different meridian systems; Sinew, Lou Primary, Divergent and the Eight Extra Meridians. In this clinic you will explore the theories and treatment strategies behind the different meridian system.

Herb Clinic

One of our faculty herbalists and up to seven advanced students will formulate an herbal prescription or recommend an herbal product based upon your individual needs. This formula will be updated in follow-up visits as needed.

Japanese Clinic

These clinics use a variety of Japanese styles, with an emphasis on Japanese therapeutic massage techniques. Techniques of needle insertion and manipulation are very gentle. Supervised student interns treat patients.

LifeLink Externship

This clinic will be held at The Life Link, located at 2325 Cerrillos Rd. This clinic helps clients maintain their sobriety while achieving their goals. The clients, some of whom have serious mental illness, are recovering from substance abuse as well as PTSD, depression, and anxiety. This externship is community style and treatments are limited to ears, face, arms and lower legs.

Secondary Channel Clinic

Secondary Channel treatments are used to alleviate a variety of ailments, such as, Wei Qi issues relating to allergies, skin, ENT (ear, nose and throat) and musculoskeletal issues. Luo treatments address blood health problems related to pain and emotions, while the Eight Extra Vessels, treat Yuan Qi issues, such as congenital chronic overwhelming challenges to the patient.

Tui Na Specialty Clinic

Physical examinations used in this clinic will be specific to Tuina/ Orthopedic testing (for example: neck, shoulder and range of motion examinations) Tui Na examinations include palpation of Hua Tou Jia Ji points. Diagnosis in the Tuina clinic will follow basic TCM concepts. Treatments will focus on hand work done in the Tui Na style with limited use of acupuncture, bleeding or moxibustion as needed.
