Guidelines:

1. CPR/First Aid must be current for all clinical observation and internships.
2. OSHA must be taken every Spring Semester.
3. A student must take at least two semesters to complete a single phase of clinic.
4. 231 & 232 are interchangeable for pre-requisite for clinic. Clinic 250, and 251 can be taken when either 231/232 has been completed. Clinic 252 and 253 may be completed when the remaining upper level point location class is completed. 254 & 255 required that both 231 and 232 have been completed.
5. No more than 4 clinic shifts in a semester
6. In certain circumstances a course may be taken out of order. Please use the Request to Waive Course Prerequisite Form.
